### **BIRTH OF JESUS \* MARY VISITS ELIZABETH \* JAMES INVITES US TO PRAY**

The angel Gabriel came to Mary and said, "Greetings, favored one! **The Lord is with you.**" **Luke 1,28**

When we pray Glorious Mysteries of the rosary we think about the wonderful times in Jesus' life and in Mary's life after the Crucifixion. **First Glorious Mystery** - The Resurrection of Jesus • Jesus was raised from the dead.

### **Sign of the Cross (1 time)**

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.                      All: Amen.

### **The Our Father (1 time)**

Leader: Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

All: Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

### **The Hail Mary (10 times)**

Leader: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

All: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of death. Amen.

### **Glory be to the Father (1 time)**

Leader: Glory Be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

All: As it was in the beginning, is now and will be forever. Amen.

### **Fatima Prayer (1 time)**

All: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in most need of your mercy.

### **Sign of the Cross (1 time)**

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.                      All: Amen.

## BEFORE BENEDICTION WITH THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All remain kneeling when priest says:

**Priest:**            **Let us pray: Lord Jesus Christ; you gave us the Eucharist as the memorial of your suffering and death. May our worship of this Sacrament of your Body and Blood help us to experience the salvation you won for us and the peace of the kingdom where you live with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.**

**People:**            **Amen.**

*Benediction – Blessing of people with the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance (people are kneeling)*
